Romans 11:33-36

³³ Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! ³⁴ "For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" ³⁵ "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?" ³⁶ For from him and through him and to him are all things. Ephesians 1:3-14

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, ⁴ even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. Ministry

I am an ordained Minister in good standing with Africa Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Kenya. I have served as a Minister and church planter in this church since 1988, since then I have planted 9 churches and I am planting a 10th one. Currently serving with Equipping Leaders International to train church leaders.

Location

My family lives south of Nairobi city in Kenya and 5 kms from the airport. I was born and raised in a remote and semi-arid part of Eastern Kenya, Kitui county, Kyuso sub-county, Ndatani village. All my parents were alive until January this year when my dear Mum went to be with the Lord at 81 years. I am survived by my father and 3 brothers and one sister.

Mission

Since the Lord called me into church planting, I found myself raising and training church leaders and handing over the planted church to these leaders I have trained. In all 9 churches I have planted I have trained a pastor and through the presbytery I would hand over the church to him as I move forward as to plant a new church or minister to a church that calls me. I came to a realization that God was calling me to raise and train Church leaders for the body of Christ. It was in 2012 when I volunteered with Equipping Leaders International to train church leaders and since then I have done training in many parts in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. In 2019 I became a full time faculty with ELI and a National Project Director in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. My clear Mission is seeing the Church Leaders trained in preaching true and sound doctrine so that in turn they can train others.

Prayer Request

For me to serve and train with ELI, I need to raise supporters who will stand with me to support in Prayer and financial support. The work of God needs brothers and sisters in the body of Christ to stand with the one called to go. In this case I am praying for God to raise men and women who can stand with me in this noble calling. I have a budget of \$30,000 for this year and a monthly budget of \$2500 that I need to raise. Therefore, my current needs are praying for men and women, church mission committees that can support me with anything from \$100, \$200, \$250, \$300, \$400, \$450 and so on. This support can be monthly, yearly or one time gift, depending on the decision one makes. No small money given from a willing heart to serve God

Brothers, I have witnessed God doing great things. Recently I held a Marriage seminar in an area dominated with Muslims and about 60 people attended. Many couples confessed that the things I taught them have never been taught to them anywhere. I have attached some pictures from this seminar for you to see. One of the ladies came to me and confessed that she has never known that the Husband is the head of the family and that she needs to be submissive to him in all things. God used this seminar to bring the couples together and confessed to each other. They are requesting if I could go back and have another seminar. Another couple requested if I could go to their rural home and teach the same things to their people. Friends these things are possible only when we partner in this ministry, without your financial support this is impossible.
